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Dear Sunday School Families:

Good Shepherd Sunday School is open to children age 2 through Grade 6. Two and three year olds have their lessons in the nursery. PreK through Grade 4 use our rotation curriculum: Focusing on the same bible story for 2-3 weeks through different rotation experiences. Grades 5 and 6 utilize a preteen/ tween-specific curriculum that enables them to make broader connections between the bible stories they've learned as children and the bible/God's story as a whole. Some things to note:

- All children that regularly attend Sunday School must have a completed registration form on file.
Children that are 6th grade and younger must be picked up at their classroom by a parent, another designated adult or a designated older student. This is to ensure that teachers know the students are going from their care directly to that of another adult. Please be prompt in picking up your children as the Age Group Leader must stay with them until they are picked up. Because children rotate classrooms, posted signs will help guide you to the location of your child's class each week.
